

The Agricultural Holdings (England) Act, 1875.

Notice under Sec. 57.

To Mr. William Robert Wallbank of Birkett
in the parish of Clapham

I hereby give you Notice that I desire that the existing contract of tenancy from year to year between us in respect of the holding by you under me, situate in the parish of Clapham in the County of York, shall remain unaffected by the above Act, and that the said Act shall not apply thereto.
