March 1870 Low Hill Farm
Richard Doughton over.
Tenant has lived 170 years in it
at Righton Falls 11 as former
Tenant of Ellerbush & Brentnall
Day at Low Hill.

In his time Ellerbush had 40 Gaber
at Little Dale and when Doughton
bought 300 acres off the Fall
every one submitted to reduction
and he gave up 6 leaving 34 Gaber
at the proper number. The late
Mr Pearson improved of this arrangement
came to by Mr Pearson with the
Farrer of Righton.
Has heard that Beatham or late
Keeper used to shoot at Little Dale
but never went with him.

Sharpley Mr Ferrers keeper goes
over ^{all} our land on Low Hill
Farm & last year stopped his
gun from killing Rabbits
He was coming over to mention
the matter to Mr Pearson but

Young Mr Jewitt when he came
